



Land Surveying Crew Member (Party Chief)

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

Data collection and total station experience, GPS experience is a plus, and must be able to work independently with Robotic Total Station. Must have experience in boundary control, topographic surveys, and construction staking. Must be able to read construction plans and make necessary calculations to establish location and elevation of elements based on those plans. Be familiar with topographic mapping features and data collection, horizontal and vertical control network. You will also check all work performed by field survey crew and instruct crew members on the proper use and care of survey equipment. You will be responsible for equipment care and daily electronic file transfers. You will also be interacting with supervising Professional Land Surveyor, office technicians, clients and our engineering department.

Requirements:

- Minimum 5 years' survey experience as a survey crew member responsible for field elements of construction surveying, topographic mapping, boundary surveying and ALTA surveys
- L.S.I.T. preferred but not required
- Valid Washington State driver's license required with a clean driving record
- Ability to provide comprehensive field notes to help in the preparation of maps, drawings and charts
- Ability to engage in field work for extended periods and occasionally under adverse weather conditions as necessitated by work assignments
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions and sketches
- Be highly motivated, a problem solver and capable of working alone
- A team player with a positive attitude
- A strong desire to continue learning, as well as a willingness to mentor more inexperienced staff
- Customer service experience is required
